### **REQUIREMENTS**

- For international students currently at US universities in F-1 status, PIP will provide guidance on transfer of status.
- A TOEFL or IELTS score is needed to apply for GAP Summer, however, if one is not available, PIP can provide an online English language evaluation at no charge.
